**General Studies Paper One (200 MARKS )**

**section I – ( GS) (100 marks) Duration: One hours**

Current events of national and international importance..

History of India and Indian National Movement.

Indian and World Geography-Physical, Social, Economic Geography of India and the World.

Indian Polity and Governance-Constitution, Political System, Panchayati Raj, Public Policy, Rights Issues, etc.

Economic and Social Development-Sustainable Development, Poverty, Inclusion, Demographics, Social Sector Initiatives, etc.

General issues on Environmental ecology, Bio-diversity and Climate Change - that do not require subject specialization.

General Science.

**section II-( CSAT) (100 marks) Duration : One hours**

Comprehension;

Interpersonal skills including communication skills;

Logical reasoning and analytical ability;

Decision making and problem solving;

General mental ability;

Basic numeracy (numbers and their relations, orders of magnitude, etc.) (Class X level), Data interpretation (charts, graphs, tables, data sufficiency etc. — Class X level);

**Note 1 : Section II - CSAT will be a qualifying paper with minimum qualifying marks fixed at 33%.**

**Note 2 : The questions will be of multiple choice, objective type.**

**Note 3 : It is mandatory for the candidate to appear in both the Papers of Entrance Examination for the purpose of evaluation. Therefore a candidate will be disqualified in case he/she does not appear in both the papers of Entrance Examination.**
